ANNUAL REPORT 2025–26

It is with great joy and gratitude that we present the Annual Report of Mar Baselios Public School for the academic year 2025–26. The year witnessed commendable progress in academics, co-curricular activities, sports, innovation, leadership and community engagement. These achievements reflect the collective efforts of our students, teachers, parents and management.

Academic Excellence

The school recorded outstanding results in the CBSE Board Examinations for Classes X and XII. More than 50% of the students secured above 90%, reflecting their sustained effort and the dedicated academic support provided by the teachers and parents.

In Class X, Mary Mathew secured 4th position at the national level and 3rd at the state level, while Kavya K Bijo secured 5th position nationally and 4th at the state level. The number of students securing all A1 grades in Class XII also increased compared with previous years, indicating a positive trend in academic performance.

The achievements of our students were recognised at the School Merit Day and the Central Sahodaya Merit Day.

Student Leadership and School Culture

The Student Council Election was conducted in a democratic spirit, culminating in the Investiture Ceremony. The oath-taking ceremony was officiated by Col. P. Sreenivasan, Commanding Officer, NCC.

The inter-house cultural fest SARANG provided a platform for students to showcase their talents. The winners progressed to the Sahodaya District-Level Competitions, BHAVASUDHA 2025, hosted by our school, where MBPS emerged as First Runner-Up.

Cultural Achievements

At the CBSE State Kalotsav held at Labour India Public School, our students secured A Grades in nearly all events and earned 212 points, the highest among CSEK member schools.

MERAKI, our inter-school cultural fest, brought together senior secondary schools from across Kottayam, promoting creativity, confidence and healthy competition. Our students also participated in various inter-school competitions outside the school and won several prizes.

Sports and Physical Education

The school hosted two major sporting events—the Baselian Basketball & Badminton Tournament and the CSEK Roller Skating Championship. Both events witnessed enthusiastic participation from several CBSE and CSEK member schools and provided our students with valuable opportunities to demonstrate their sporting skills.

Social Responsibility and Community Engagement

The Baselian Walkathon was organised as a campaign against drug abuse. The event was flagged off and joined by District Collector Sri. Chetan Kumar Meena, IAS, giving the campaign wider visibility.

Students actively participated in community outreach initiatives, including visits to old age homes, along with field trips, library and museum visits and industrial visits. These experiences helped nurture empathy, social responsibility and experiential learning.

Clubs, Celebrations and Enrichment

The school observed important occasions including World Environment Day, World Oceans Day, International Yoga Day, Reading Day, Independence Day, Onam and Children's Day through meaningful activities that promoted environmental awareness, patriotism, reading habits and holistic well-being.

Various clubs, including the Nature Club, Quiz & Debate Club, Nallapadam Charity and Balajanasakhyam, were inaugurated and conducted activities throughout the year.

Innovation, STEM and Atal Tinkering Lab

The Atal Tinkering Lab continued to serve as a centre for innovation in Robotics, Artificial Intelligence and STEM education. Students developed a digital voting system for the Student Council Election, participated in a drone-making workshop and undertook a community outreach programme.

The Robofusion Fest showcased 20 student projects in Robotics, demonstrating the technical skills and innovative thinking developed through the training and activities of the laboratory.

Student Development and Teacher Development

Teacher training programmes were conducted to strengthen pedagogical practices and support continuous professional development. Students were provided with skill-development programmes, career-guidance sessions and awareness workshops to prepare them for future academic and career pathways.

Parent–School Partnership

The school maintained regular interaction with parents through PTA Executive Committee meetings, general and individual meetings, and Open Houses. These engagements supported the academic, personal and overall development of students.

International, National and State-Level Achievements

Madhav Mahesh of Class X was selected to participate in the BRICS Youth International Festival in Kazan, Russia, after emerging as the winner in competitions conducted by Team Resorcio in association with the Consulate of Russia.

Vismaya Rajeev of Class XI represented Kerala at the Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. Selected through national-level competitions, she presented her ideas on "Empowering Women and Improving Social Indicators".

Zahwa Yara Nikhil of Class VI secured the First Runner-Up position in the 22nd National SIP Abacus Competition held in Chennai.

Saira Elizabeth of Class VI won the gold medal in the RFO All Kerala Roller Skating Championship and secured second position in the Under-12 category of the All Kerala One Day Chess Tournament organised by the Kerala Chess Academy.

Eva Lijo of Class VI became the champion in the Under-11 Girls category at the Kerala State Open Rapid Chess Championship organised by the Kerala Chess Association.
